## What You'll Do

As a TreeCasa Artist Resident, you are invited to inhabit this space and pursue create unique body of work that inspires and engages a global community. The Artist Residency experience includes:

- -1-3 month stay, private room with communal spaces
- -3 meals a day, organic garden goodies, restaurant and bar discount
- -Access to all Treecasa amenities: yoga, pools, tree lounges, trails
- -Daily shuttle to and from SJDS city center to explore local culture
- -Time and space to produce art series and leave a piece to mark your experience
- -Artwork featured in a dedicated space and with a gallery exhibition event
- -Artist profile and journey promoted through multimedia platforms







## Your TreeCasa Experience

Your time at TreeCasa can be what you make it. We recommend a mix of inspiration, play and relaxation.

- -Wake up early for sunrise yoga; finish in time for a mid-morning massage
- -Soak in the sun on our private beach; light a bonfire and watch the sunset
- -Catch up on some reading by one of the pools, then dive off the waterfall or slide
- -Hit the jungle trails through our El Encanto property for horseback riding, biking or hiking
- -Encounter a tribe of Howler monkeys in the trees or a fleet of exotic butterflies
- -Dance to a multicultural DJ on a 3-story tree platform while sipping a tropical cocktail
- -Watch baby turtles hatch on the beach and help release them into the ocean
- -Trek through cloud forests to meet some dormant and active volcanoes (19 in total)
- -Learn to surf up and down the Emerald Coast; discover majestic beaches
- -Take a peaceful sunset paddleboard excursion or sail the coast on a catamaran
