- Music/Vibe: audio/visual setup, acoustic space engineering, playlist programming, playing/spinning for inaugural events, lining up a stream of musical talent for bimonthly gigs from global and local musicians
- Landscaping and Permaculture: establish farm-to-table permaculture, expand organic gardens, create living "rooms" and gardens, walking tour paths, integrating ethnobotany
- Food and Menu Design: incorporating more of the local, seasonal, organically-grown stuff from the gardens in restaurant and bar offerings
- Planning and Building: trails for biking, hiking, horses, workshop/gathering spaces, outdoor rooms and meditative spaces
- Art and Aesthetic Experience: create unique features and art installations for indoor spaces and vast grounds, interior/exterior design, local art curation (see attached photos and site plan plenty of space to create beautiful things!)
- Volunteer Program Development: help me build out volunteer program structure and tracks, workshop and course design, operational ethos and resources
